Chairwoman Bette Jane Kowalski presided. Vice Chairman Angel G. Estrada, Freeholder Chester Holmes, Freeholder Adrian O. Mapp, Freeholder Alexander Mirabella, Freeholder Rick Proctor, Freeholder Deborah P. Scanlon and Freeholder Daniel P. Sullivan were present. Freeholder Nancy Ward was absent.

Also present were County Counsel Robert E. Barry, Esq., County Manager George W. Devanney and Clerk of the Board Nicole L. DiRado.

The Prayer and Salute to the Flag were led by the Clerk of the Board.

Chairwoman Kowalski asked that everyone remain standing for a moment of silence in memory of Corporal Luigi Marciante, Jr., who was killed in Iraq. Corporal Marciante, Jr., was born and raised in Elizabeth.

There were no comments.

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Chairwoman Kowalski stated that there were several Resolutions to be presented.

Chairwoman Kowalski and Freeholder Scanlon called upon Michael Yesanko and presented him with a Resolution for the Union Township Historical Society on celebrating their 50th Anniversary. Chairwoman Kowalski read the Resolution aloud and also stated that Mr. Yesanko worked on the County's 150th Anniversary. Mr. Yesanko thanked the Board for the recognition.

Freeholder Holmes and Director of Human Services Frank Guzzo presented a Resolution to Cary Scott, congratulating him on receiving the "Paratransit Driver of the Year" Award. Freeholder Holmes stated that he takes driving our Paratransit clients seriously. He read the Resolution aloud. Director Guzzo congratulated Mr. Scott for doing such a great job and was happy to see that the person selected was from Union County.

Mr. Scott stated that in 1986 there were only 2 Paratransit vehicles that the clients were assisted with and now there are 50 vehicles. He stated that there are many drivers that qualify to receive the award. He also commented on the proposed Route 22 Shuttle and stated that this is a great plan. He thanked the Board for the recognition.

Freeholder Mirabella presented an award to Andrew Pavlica for receiving the designation of Master Municipal Clerk through the IIMC Master Municipal Clerk Academy Program. Freeholder Mirabella stated that Mr. Pavlica is a good friend of Union County and has not missed a meeting of his governing body in 20 years. Mr. Pavlica thanked Freeholder Mirabella and the entire Board for the recognition.

Seven members of the Board voted in the affirmative for the Agenda Meeting Minutes of September 20, 2007 with Freeholder Mirabella abstaining and Freeholder Ward absent.

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The next order of business was the Final Reading of Ordinance No. 657-2007. The title of the Ordinance was read by the Clerk of the Board.

ORDINANCE NO. 657-2007

ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE CONSENT OF THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION TO THE ISSUANCE BY THE UNION COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY OF ITS NOT TO EXCEED REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2007 (AFRICAN AMERICAN FUND OF NEW JERSEY PLAINFIELD PROJECT) IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$7,000,000 IN CONNECTION WITH THE AUTHORITY'S PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Union County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") has been duly created by an ordinance of the Board of Chosen Freeholders (the "Board of Freeholders") of the County of Union, New Jersey (the "County"), as public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey (the "State") pursuant to and in accordance with the county improvement authorities law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1960 of the State, as amended and supplemented from time to time (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, The Torain Group on behalf of its Client, the Black United Fund or its affiliate or transferee has requested the Authority's assistance in relation to the expansion of a pre-school facility in the City of Plainfield; and

WHEREAS, the City has expressed its support for the Project in a letter from the Mayor dated August 7, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Authority proposes to finance the Project through the issuance of one or more series of Bonds (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$7,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Bonds shall have such other terms as set forth in those certain resolutions authorizing the issuance of the "Revenue Bonds, Series 2007 (Black United Fund-Plainfield Project)" of the Union County Improvement Authority to be adopted by the Authority prior to the issuance of the Bonds (the "Bond Resolution"; the Bond Resolution, and any amendments or supplements thereto in accordance with the terms thereof may be collectively referred to as the "Bond Resolution"); and

WHEREAS, the principal of (including sinking fund installments, if any) and interest on the Bonds when due may be, if the Authority determines it to be in its best interest, insured by a municipal bond insurance company (the "Bond Insurer") in accordance with the terms of a new issue municipal bond insurance policy (the "Bond Insurance Policy"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority shall make application to the Local Finance Board in the Division of Local Government Services of the Department of Community Affairs of the State (the "Local Finance Board") for the Local Finance Board's review of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Authority believes: (i) it is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose; (ii) said purpose is for the health, wealth, convenience or betterment of the inhabitants of the County; (iii) the amounts to be expended for said purpose are not unreasonable or exorbitant; and (iv) the proposal is an efficient and feasible means of providing services for the needs of the inhabitants of the County and will not create an undue financial burden to be placed upon the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY, as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with Section 13 and all other applicable law, the Board of Freeholders hereby consents to (i) the Project and the financing of same, (ii) the execution and delivery by the Authority of the Financing Documents and such other documents as necessary and reasonable for the transaction, which documents shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board prior to the issuance of any Bonds, (iii) the adoption by the Authority of the Bond Resolution, and (iv) the issuance, sale and delivery of the Bonds to effect such purpose. The consent hereto given to the Financing Documents contemplates the insertion of the final financing terms.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take at the time and in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. Upon the adoption hereof, the Clerk of the Board of Freeholders shall forward certified copies of this ordinance to the County Manager, County Counsel, Executive Director of the Authority, and John G. Hudak, Esq., Bond Counsel to the Authority.

Tina Renna, Cranford, asked for an explanation of the Black United Fund. Director Guzzo stated it is a social service multi-purpose agency. Ms. Renna asked if the amount was appropriated for running or buying the agency. County Manager Devanney stated that it is a construction project.

PUBLIC COMMENT PORTION CONCLUDED

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Freeholder Mapp made comments at this time stating that that he is a resident of Plainfield and knows little about the Black United Fund Ordinance. He stated that concerns have been brought to his attention by the residents of the City of Plainfield. He said this is a significant investment and asked who would stand behind it if goes into default. County Counsel Barry stated that the County

is not financially responsible should the Black United Fund default. They are revenue bonds and will pose tax exempt bonds. He stated that pursuant to State statute, consent is required by the Board of Chosen Freeholders for issuance of bonds by the Union County Improvement Authority.

Freeholder Mapp urged the Board to table the Ordinance.

Freeholder Holmes recommended that the Ordinance continue with the information provided.

Freeholder Sullivan disagreed with Freeholder Mapp. He stated that the Union County Improvement Authority determines an agency's financial security and viability to repay a bond. Based upon the UCIA's track record with completing their due diligence and success rate in financing projects throughout the County, this Ordinance would not have reached this level unless the background work was done, he stated.

Chairwoman Kowalski called for a motion to suspend the rules. On a motion made by Freeholder Mapp and seconded by Freeholder Mirabella, roll call showed eight members of the Board voted in the affirmative with Freeholder Ward absent.

Freeholder Mapp called for a motion to table Ordinance 657-2007. There was no second, therefore, the motion failed.

Freeholder Scanlon moved Ordinance No. 657-2007 for Final Reading and authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the same in accordance with the law. The motion was seconded by Freeholder Mirabella. Roll call showed seven members of the Board voted in the affirmative and Freeholder Mapp voted in the negative with Freeholder Ward absent.

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The next order of business was the First Reading of Ordinance No. 658-2007. The title of the Ordinance was read by the Clerk of the Board.

Chapter 104, RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS

ARTICLE II, Fees

§ 104-3. Copies of minutes and other government records.

A. The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Union hereby establishes the cost for copies of minutes of this Board's meetings and for all other government records maintained by the County in accordance with the New Jersey "Open Public Records Act" (OPRA) (*N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.*) shall be as follows:

(1) First page to tenth page; ~~No Charge.~~

(2) Eleventh page ~~and every page thereafter: \$0.10 per page.~~

Authorizing the County Manager to enter into subcontracts with the municipalities/agencies listed on the Alliance Spending Plan for the grant period of January 1 through December 31, 2008. Finally, authorizing the transfer of funds among the municipalities/agencies listed during the contract period should service needs change and/or if any of the listed municipalities/agencies fails to meet its contractual obligation. Municipal/agency grant recipients have an obligation to make a matching cash appropriation of 25% of the award and 75% in-kind match.

The primary purpose of the shuttle is to take pedestrians to work.

2007-918 VICE CHAIRMAN ESTRADA, amending Resolution No. 2007-705, adopted July 26, 2007, a contract with **Connex Transit, Chicago, Illinois**, to award FY 2006 Federal Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) funds to implement a **Route 22 Pedestrian Shuttle** in October 2007, increasing the contract for **an additional amount of \$55,975 for a new contract amount of \$2,597,905**.

On a motion made by Freeholder Sullivan and seconded by Freeholder Mirabella, roll call showed eight members of the Board voted in the affirmative with Freeholder Ward absent.

He also said the weather cooperated and there was no trouble. He congratulated everyone involved on behalf of the Board.

Freeholder Sullivan stated that he wanted to add a comment regarding Ordinance 2007-657, stating that he has full confidence in the Union County Improvement Authority and the experts they hire.

Freeholder Mirabella commented on MusicFest stating that he had a great time and he contributes much of the praise to County Manager Devaney in his leadership.
