- 8 Somerset County Administrator is a 35 year county employee. Also worth noting: Only county with on-line OPRA capabilities. I placed my OPRA request on line and my request was filled in the same day.
- 9 Sussex county Freeholder Director receives \$500 additional in salary
- 10 a) Warren county Freeholder salaries have only been raised \$1,000 in 10 years. The salary is the same since 1999; b) One county car is shared between director and department heads; c) Worth noting: Received all information in one pleasant phone call. Did not have to place an OPRA request. When I complimented Mr. Charlton on this he replied "We have nothing to hide." Mr. Charlton also asked to see my completed report.
- 11 a) Essex County only the Freeholder Director is given a county vehicle; b) Only county to charge me for documents (\$3.75); also difficult to obtain information from, not in an obstronctionst way; just extreme incompetance.
